❖ PROPERTY UPDATE - Over the last few months, we have received multiple inquiries regarding purchasing our field in front of the building. As a result of those inquiries, several key meetings around this topic have taken place. First, the Administrative Council(AC) met with and invited counsel from a few congregational members. Secondly, the AC and Ministry Coordinating Team (MCT) convened a joint meeting. Finally, a congregational meeting was held.

The thoughts and opinions shared have been diverse and expressed with varying levels of passion. Since the congregational meeting, the MCT and AC have each met and have agreed that in light of these conversations, we believe the Chapel would benefit from a renewed commitment to a common vision, core values, and focus. As a first step in that process, the AC and MCT will have a joint meeting to review and update our Mission statement and Five Year Focus. Any property questions will be tabled until this process is complete.

A call had been expressed for the congregation to be in prayer for direction regarding property decisions. While still important, we now ask for your prayers in anticipation of the AC and MCT meeting to review and clarify our focus and vision. -Cliff Hershey
